


How to use Kidblog

- 1) Go to your class blog website on Kidblog. You can get the web address from your teacher.
- 2) Find and select your name, type your password, and press Log In



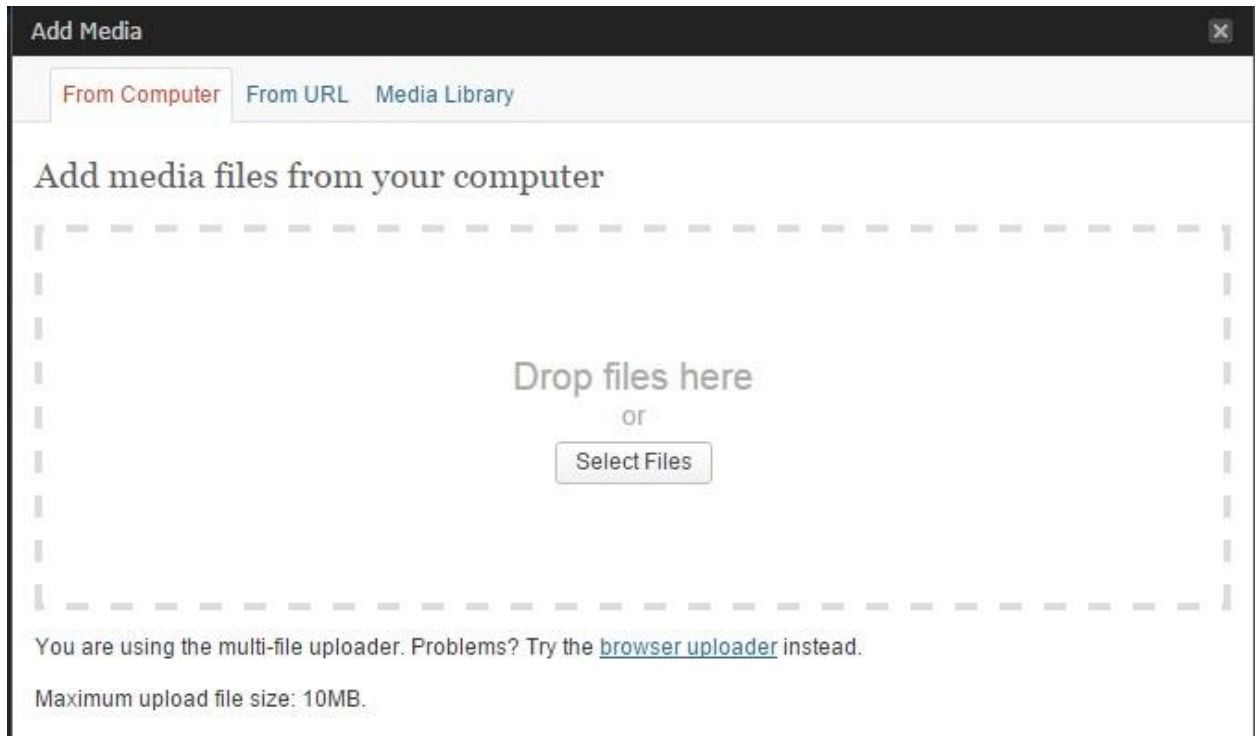

- 3) To add a new post, type in the title of the post and add your content to the box below.

- 4) You can embed links, images, videos and more into your posts. To add content, click on Upload/Insert Media, and then you can drag or browse for the media you want to include.



- 5) Be sure to click on “Save Draft” while you are working on your post to save the content.
- 6) When done preparing your post, click on the publish button. This will allow others to see your post.



- 7) To add comments to another post, click on “go to class blog.” You will be able to see the most recent posts, and a list of the blog directory.
- 8) Click on the title that you want to comment on.
- 9) Scroll to the bottom of the page and add a comment where it says to Leave a Comment. When done, press the “Submit Comment” button.
